Dear Families

Over the last few weeks we have had an increasing number of students bringing fidget spinners to school. While we recognise that some students benefit from using a fidget spinner they can become a distraction in class preventing, students from engaging in their learning. They can also cause disagreements if spinners are loaned to other students or are lost.

Recently at a staff meeting we discussed the use of fidget spinners at school. Staff have agreed that we are happy for fidget spinners to come to school. However if they become a distraction in class and prevent students from doing their learning, students will be asked to give them to the class teacher. The fidget spinner will then be returned at the end of the day. If this behaviour continues then the family will be contacted and the student will not be allowed to bring the fidget spinner to school.

We would also like to remind families that if fidget spinners are brought to school they are the responsibility of students. Therefore if they get lost or stolen the school will not take responsibility for their recovery.

If you have any questions about fidget spinners or need further clarification please contact the class teacher or myself.

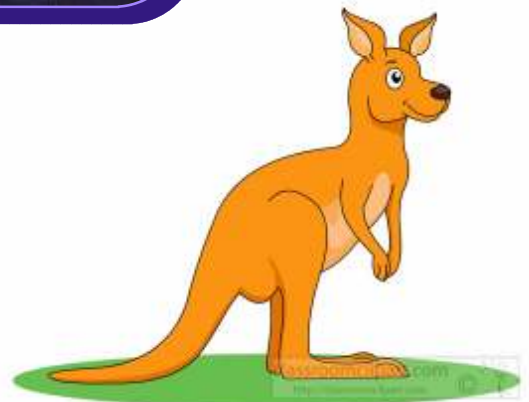
