We have been looking at how we can use voice and movement to portray the emotions of our characters.

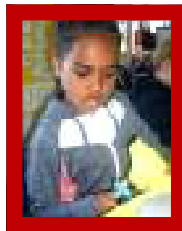
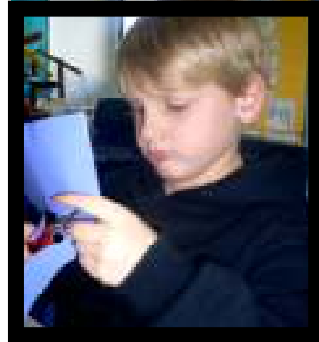
