We enjoyed learning new dance moves when Footsteps visited our school in term 1 and we had lots of fun.

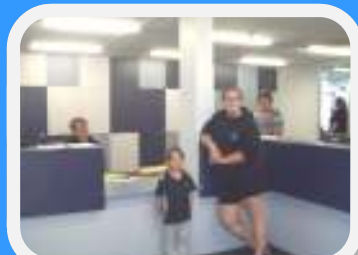

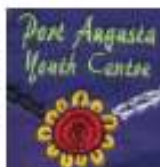
