Guest Speaker and Facilitator, Professor Martin Westwell

He is the first Director of the Flinders Centre for Science Education in the 21st Century, and is a member on the SACE Board of South Australia. After completing his degree and PhD at Cambridge University, Martin moved to Oxford University as a Research Fellow in Biological and Medical Sciences. Martin left academia to work in the biotechnology industry and then with a number of science education organisations returning to Oxford in 2005 as the Deputy Director of the Institute for the Future of the Mind. Throughout all of the work at the Institute, Martin worked with government, teachers, parents and others to provide access to scientific evidence to help inform their decision-making about the learning and education of young people. Martin brings a scientist's view to learning, science education, policy and industry engagement.
