STUDENT ENROLMENTS FOR 2022

To help us in our decisions, we also take into account information from families but do not guarantee the requests can be accommodated given the complexity of the task. If you have information regarding your child's learning, social, physical and developmental needs that you would like us to consider I ask that you put this in writing addressed to me by **Week 3, Friday 29 October**. Please note I cannot consider requests for specific teachers. If you have given the school information about your child in the past please make sure you pass this information on again to ensure it is considered for 2022.

We are also aware that there are many families who are intending on enrolling their children for next year. If you haven't done so already please come into the front office and fill in an enrolment form so that we ensure your child is placed in a class. Likewise, if circumstances have changed and you are planning to send your child to a different school next year please let us know.
