## From the Principal



Dear families,

Today the State Emergency Management Committee has announced changes to face mask requirements in education settings.

From **Monday 30 May**, face masks will be:

- Strongly recommended (but not required) for all adults - including visitors and parents - while indoors, except when teaching or interacting with children
- Strongly recommended (but not required) for students in years 3 to 12 while indoors.

Students and staff will be encouraged and supported to continue wearing a face mask if they choose to.

Supplies of surgical face masks will continue to be provided by the Department for Education to our school.

### **Face masks for close contacts**

If your child is a close contact and aged 12 years or older, they must wear a face mask when they are outside of the home for 7 days following exposure as per the SA Health close contact guidelines.

Face masks are strongly recommended (but not required) for classroom contacts.

### **Face mask use in outbreaks**

The Department for Education and SA Health have advised that face masks will be required to be worn in education settings where COVID-19 transmission reaches certain thresholds, based on SA Health advice.

In these instances, face masks will be required to be worn indoors by all staff and visitors in the school, preschool or and children's centre for a 14-day period.

You will be advised of the dates that face masks will be required if we reach these outbreak thresholds at our school.

Exemptions will be made for students or staff who have a medical condition, such as problems with their breathing, a serious skin condition on the face, a disability, or a mental health condition.

Thank you to all parents and students for your cooperation and assistance in implementing the face mask measures at our school.

# Sghirripa's Spiel

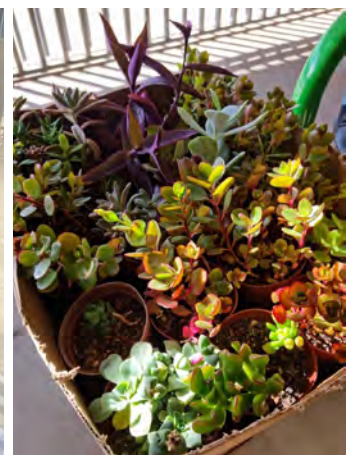


Welcome back to Term 2! I hope everyone had a lovely holiday break and enjoyed your two weeks away from school.

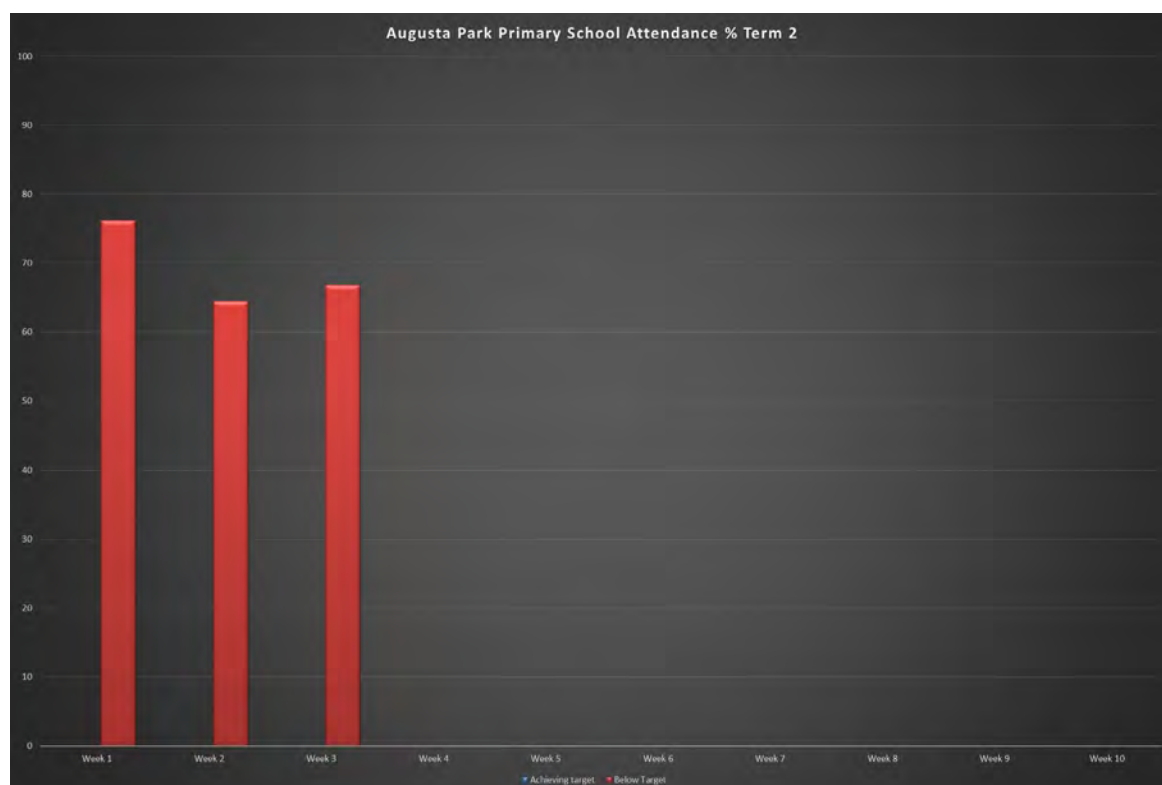

80%	=	<b>190 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR</b> 32 days in total or 6 weeks and 2 days





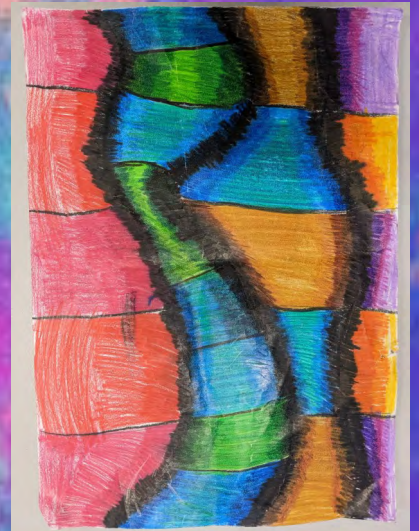

# Art

In Term 1 we spent a lot of time in our art lessons learning how to use different techniques with a range of materials. We've been focusing on trying different approaches and colour combinations on draft pieces of art so our final versions are the best they can be. We have been experimenting with lead pencil, coloured pencils, pastels, oil pastels, paint and felt tip pens.



We are learning that spending a bit of time trialling combinations of colours and pressure helps us to make our finished art look much better





We have been trying out patterns in lead pencil before working on our 'good copy' in felt tip and creating pastel backgrounds



The class worked on their ability to blend different colours before making shapes and putting together abstract collages.



Learning is all about taking risks, having a go and persevering, even when things aren't quite right at first. It's been fantastic seeing how students have exemplified these qualities in their art. It will be great seeing what else they create this year.
