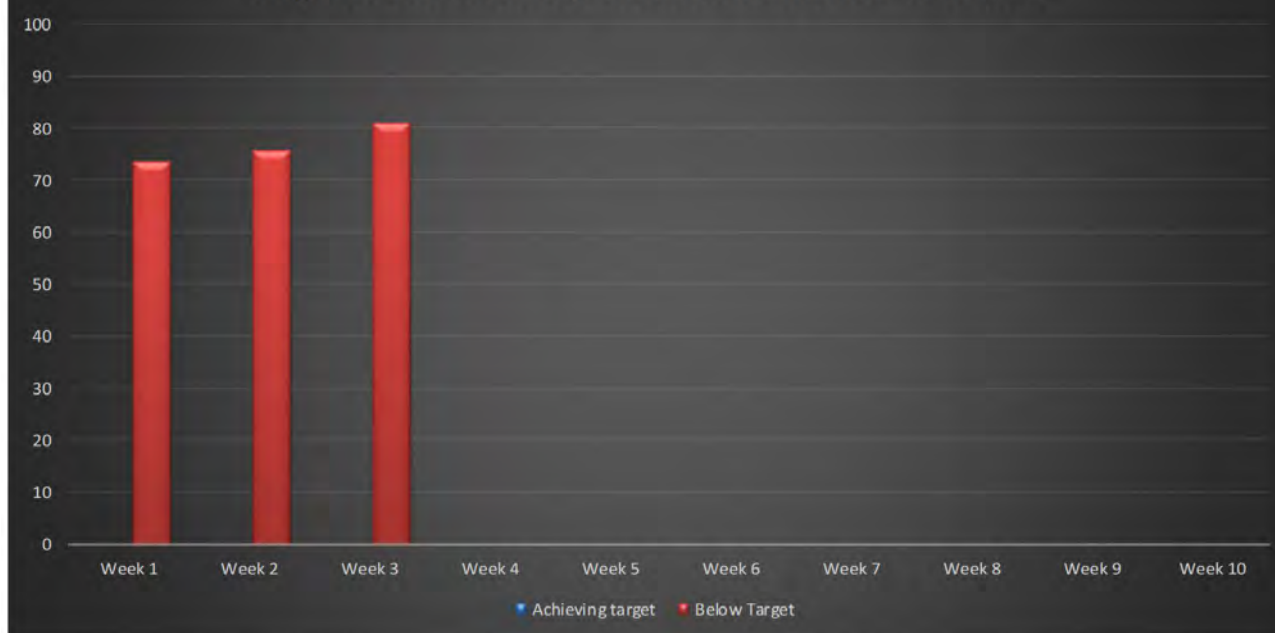

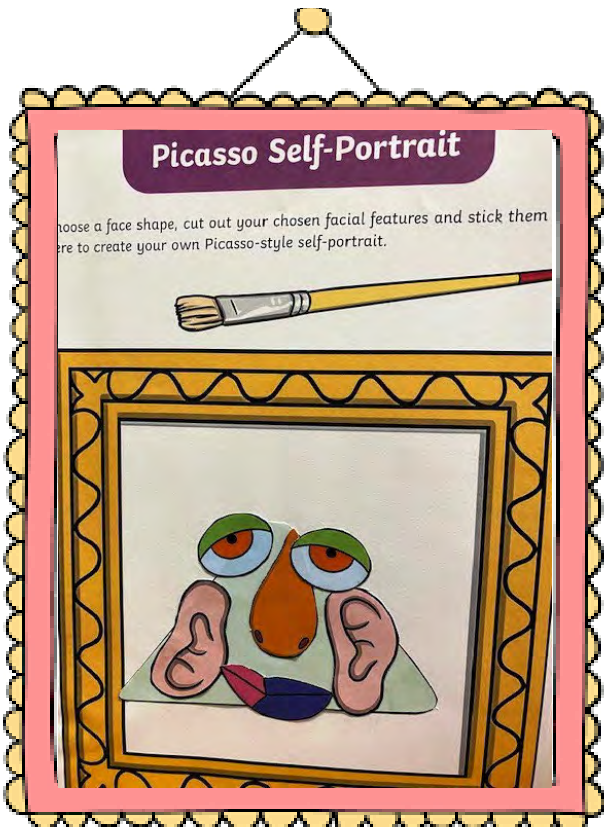


Augusta Park Primary School Attendance % Term 3



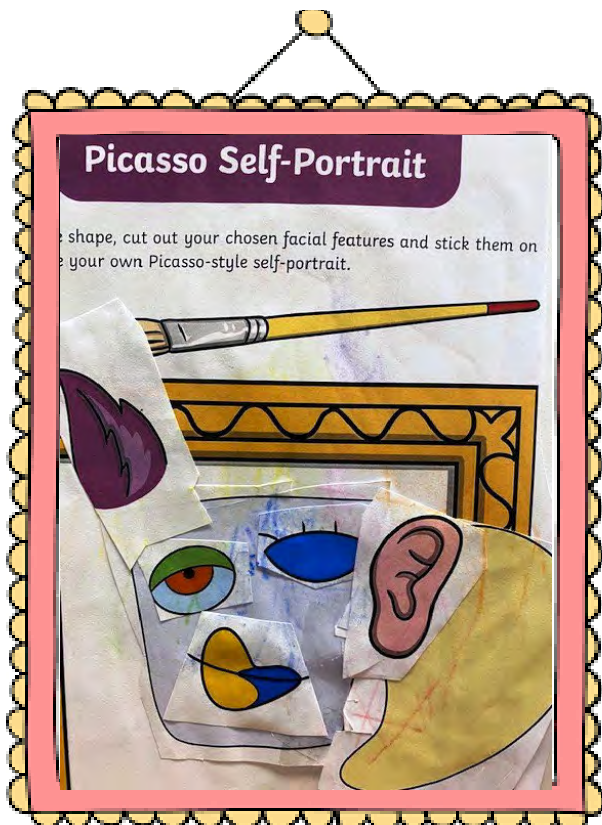
In our Art lessons we have learnt about famous artists and the types of art that they create. We chose to look at how artists create portraits and then created some of our own.
