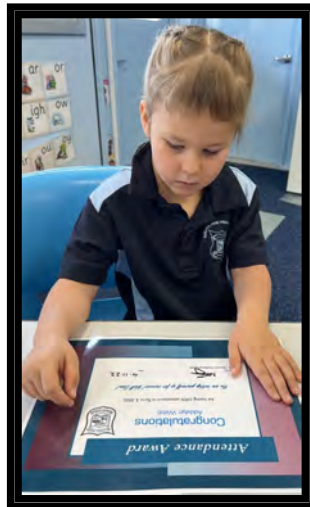

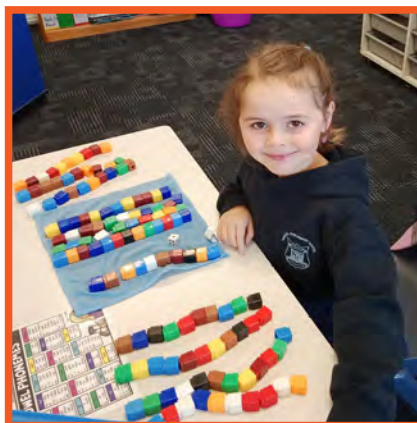


Mrs Elliot's Class News
