## **Tuesday, 15 November 2022**

### **8:50am – 10:00am: Parent Information Session and School tour**

### **10:00am – 11:20am:**

Families will leave and the children will take part in activities with their teachers until the end of recess play time. Please bring a piece of fruit/vegetable, water bottle and a healthy snack for recess. Children will also need a sun safe hat.

## **Tuesday, 22 November 2022**

### **8:50am – 11:20am**

Children are dropped off and collected from their classroom to take part in activities with other children and their teachers. They will stay at school until the end of recess play time. Please bring a piece of fruit/vegetable, water bottle and a healthy snack for recess. Children will also need a sun safe hat.

## **Tuesday, 29 November 2022**

### **8:50am – 1:30pm**

Children stay at school until the end of lunch play time. Please bring a fruit snack, water bottle, recess, lunch and a sun safe hat. Children can be collected from their classroom at 1:30pm.

## **Tuesday, 6 December 2022**

### **8:50am – 3:10pm**

Children have a full day at school including recess and lunch. Please bring a packed recess, water bottle, fruit snack, lunch and a sun-safe hat.
