Reminder School Closure and Student Free Day

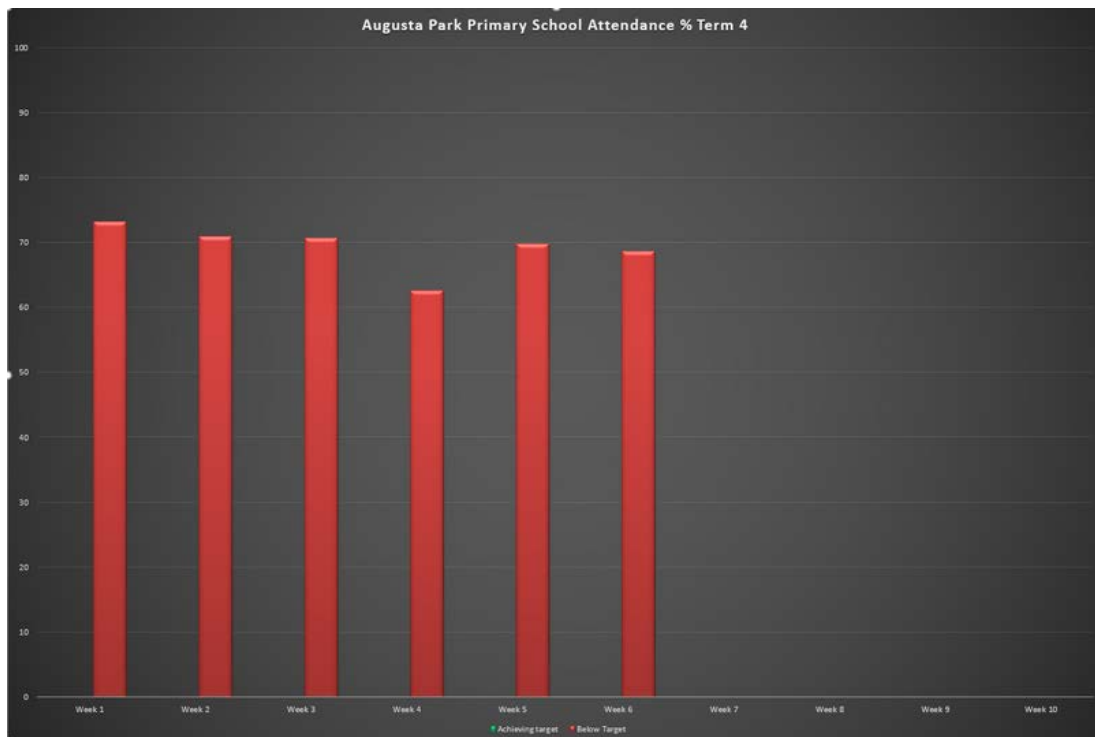
