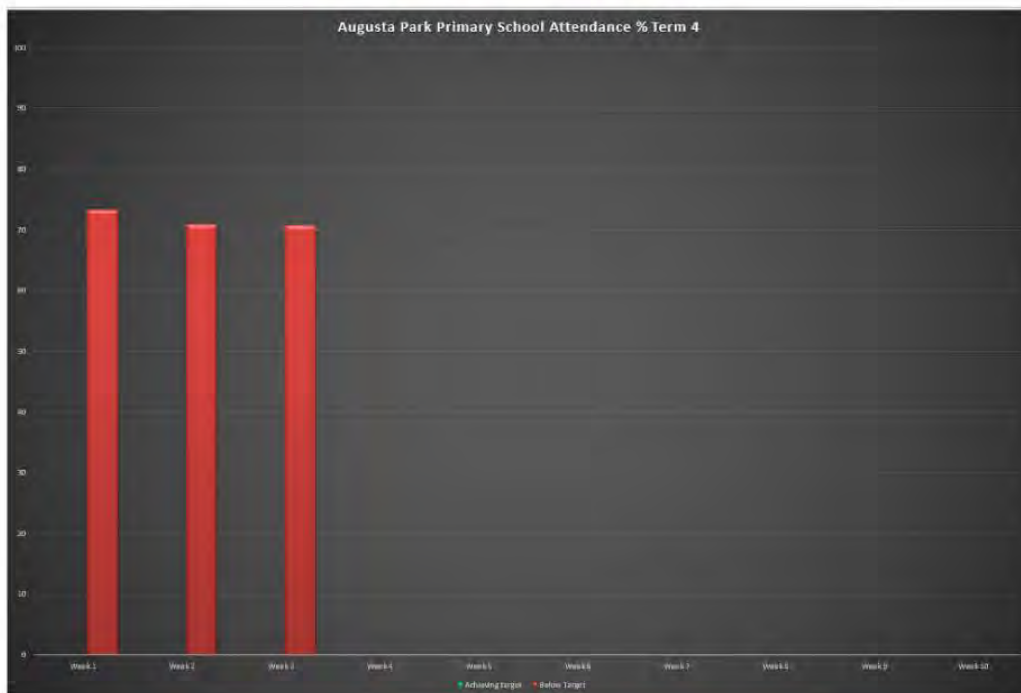

We raised a total of \$80.00

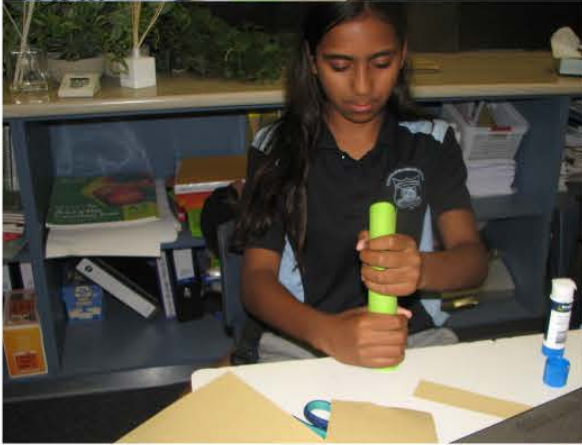

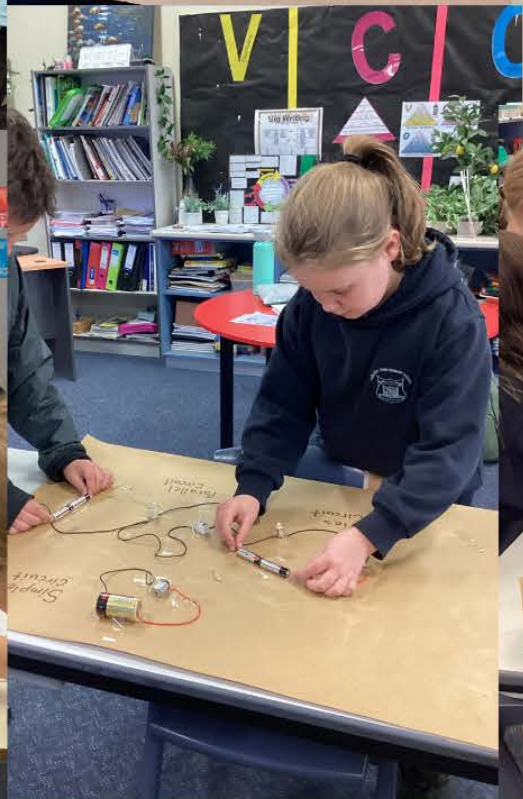
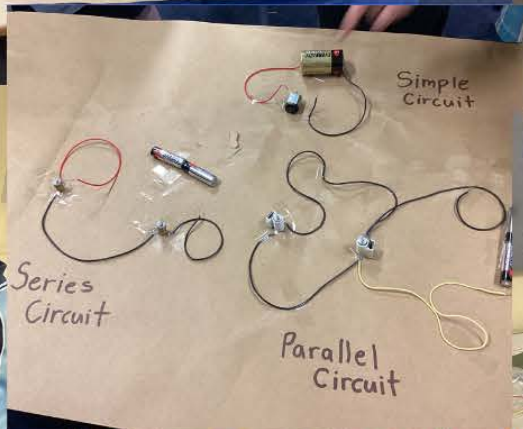
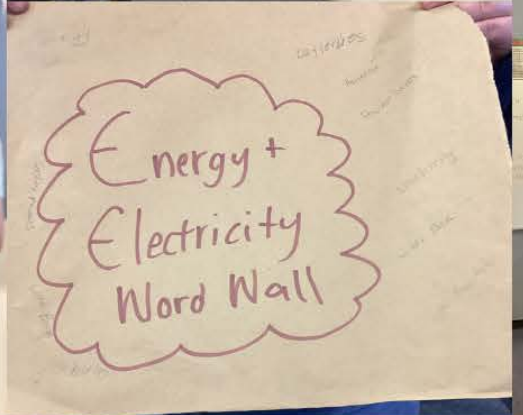
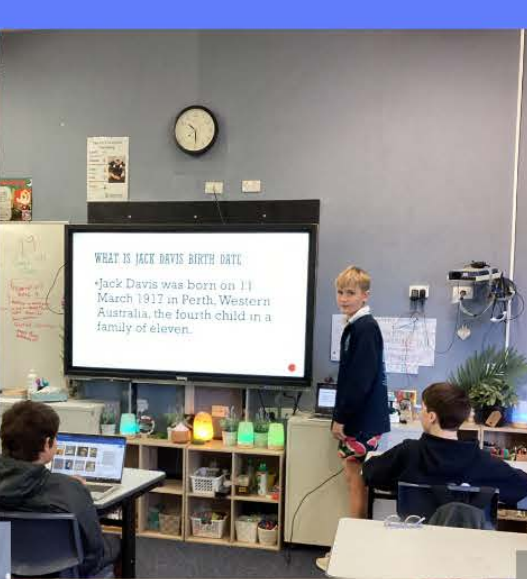
We have been learning about electric flow through an electric circuit. We conducted experiments using open and closed circuits. We have been also learning about electric conductors and insulators.
