Dear Families,



Welcome back to Term 2. We have a very busy and exciting term ahead with some very special events taking place. The most notable event is our Sports Day which will be the first time we will have our three new teams competing in this event. We are very much looking forward to this day. Miss Bishop and the school events committee have been busily planning for this day and look forward to sharing more information with you soon via Facebook and Seesaw.

In some very exciting news for our school on Tuesday I was informed we will be receiving \$3.09 million in funding from the Federal Government as part of the School Upgrade Funds to upgrade our resource centre and outdoor learning environment. Last term I applied for this funding so that we can establish a modern and flexible resource hub with direct access to outdoor learning areas, enabling effective STEM teaching and boosting students' IT skills. In addition, we plan to use this space to engage with the community by providing services like workshops, clubs, and support programs for parents and students.

We also plan to create a contemporary outdoor learning environment, including a nature play area, ensuring inclusivity and safety for all students. By replacing our playgrounds, we aim to offer students: increased safe play opportunities; enhanced imaginative and sensory play for social and emotional development, fine and gross motor skills; and age-appropriate play areas accessible to students with disabilities


This is wonderful news for our school community and we can't wait to share further details as this project progresses.
