We are also welcoming our new mid-year intake of reception students. We can't wait to see them grow and learn alongside their classmates.

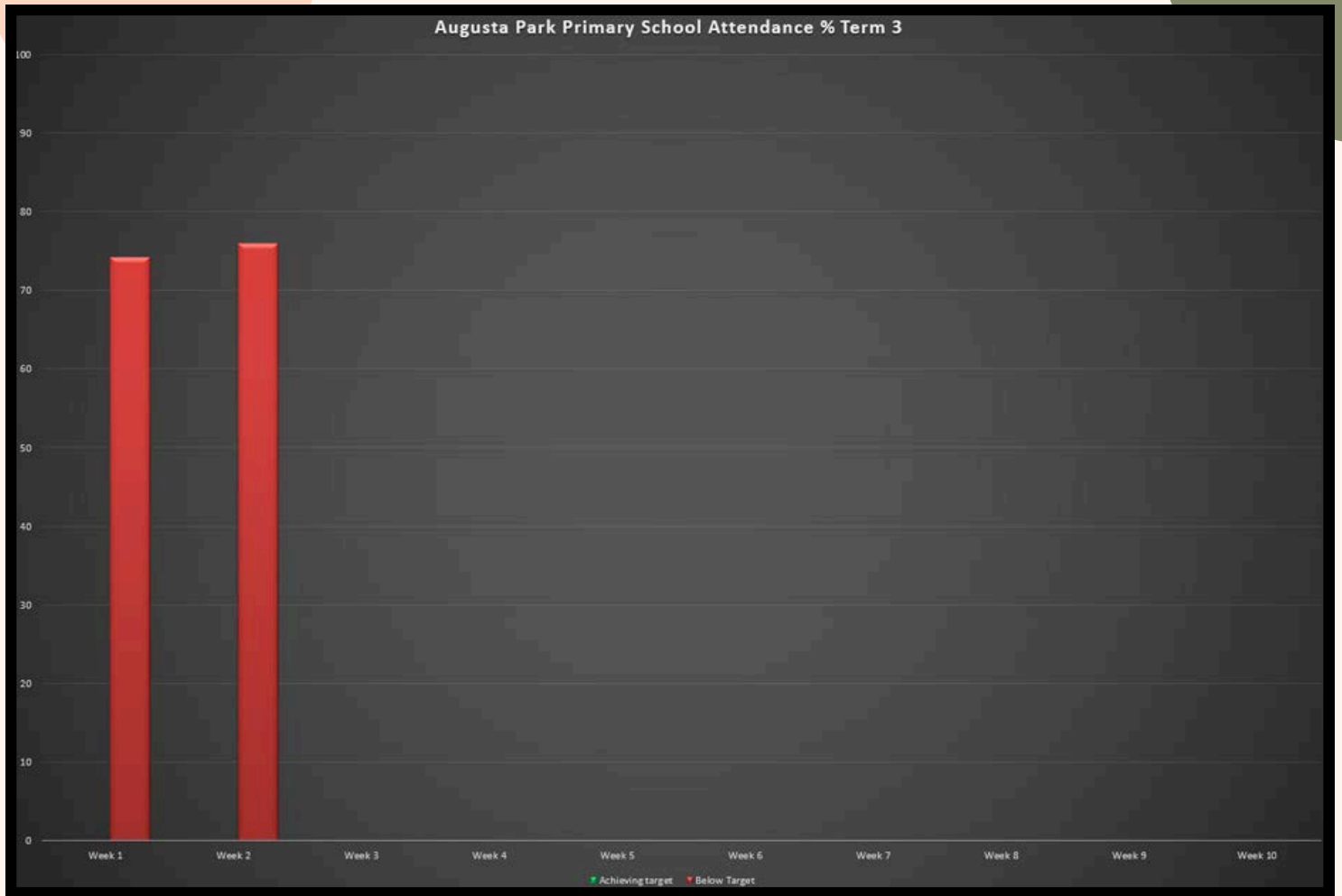

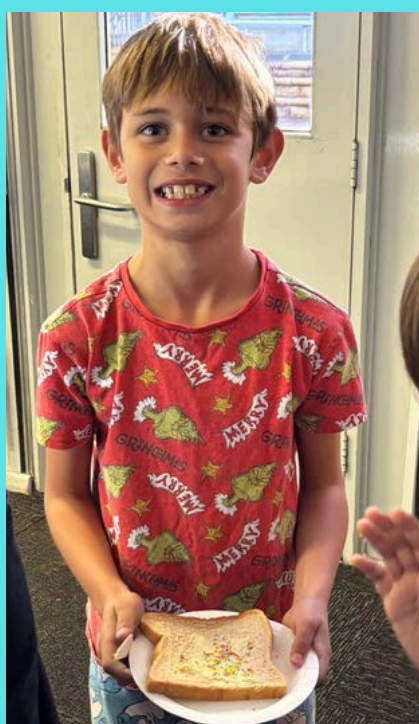
Why is attending school important?
